

RESOLUTION NO. 2025-06

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PALOUSE, WASHINGTON, establishing the rate for water sold in bulk from the municipal water system.

BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Palouse that the rate for water sold in bulk from the municipal water system shall be the same rate as that charged to the residential customers located outside the corporate limits of the City of Palouse, including to the Water System Reserve Fund.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the bulk sales of water shall be subject to the following conditions:

- 1) The purchaser must install and use an appropriate anti-backflow device approved by the Public Works Superintendent;
- 2) If the purchaser draws water from a city fire hydrant, there shall be an additional hook-up charge of \$35.00 assessed to the purchase, and the hook-up shall be made under the supervision of the Public Works Department.
- 3) All charges for hook-up shall be paid in advance, prior to the delivery of any water to the purchaser; and
- 4) The city reserves the right to suspend water service to any bulk purchaser at any time, without prior notice, should the Mayor or Public Works supervisor, in their sole discretion, deem it necessary or prudent to conserve water for the municipal purposes (e.g. supplying water to regular consumers of the municipal water supply system or supplying water for municipal projects).
