

RESOLUTION NO. 2026-10

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PALOUSE setting a one-year excess property tax levy which will be used for street improvements and equipment.

WHEREAS, the City Council of Palouse, after duly considering the City's budget and seeing a great need for providing street improvements and equipment, has determined that this requires a special levy.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF PALOUSE, WASHINGTON, that the Whitman County Auditor is requested to place the following proposition on the November 3, 2026, General Election Ballot, to be voted upon by the voters of the City of Palouse:

**PALOUSE PROPOSITION NO. 3
EXCESS PROPERTY TAX LEVY**

For the purpose of funding street improvements and equipment, the City Council of the City of Palouse proposes, pursuant to RCW 84.52.052, to impose an excess property tax levy upon all taxable property within the City in the amount of \$50,000.00, an estimated \$0.6641 per \$1,000.00 of assessed value in the year 2026 for collection in 2027, as provided in Resolution 2026-10.
